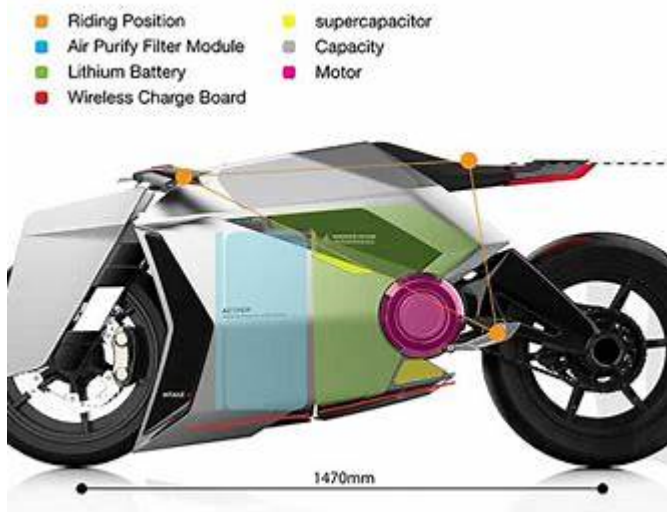

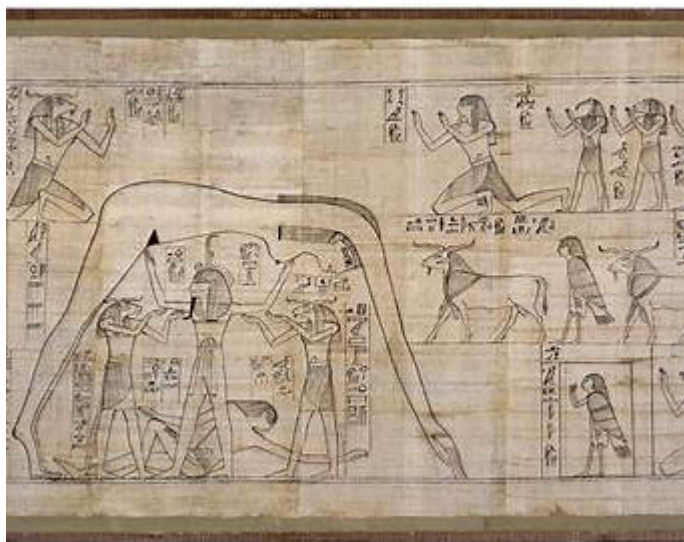

To the Egyptians, these were the *Netjeru*,
the gods born from the Field.
To modern science, these are the **fundamental forces**
emerging from symmetry-breaks in the quantum vacuum.

Same truth, different language.

THE COVENANT OF EPET

When the worlds were seeded,
Epet turned to humanity — still unformed —
and spoke into their waiting souls:
